#### Name of the course with duration.

The Maheshtala Municipal Institute of Nursing Sciences will impart 4 year (08 Semester) course on B.Sc Nursing & 3 years Course on GNM.

# 2. Eligibility criteria for admission -

The minimum age of admission shall be 17 years on 31st December of the year in which admission is sought. The maximum age limit for admission shall be 35 years in which admission is sought both in GNM & B.Sc Course.

# Minimum educational qualification

- a) "INC guideline for B.Sc. (Nursing). The minimum Educational requirements shall be 45% in 10+2 system with Science (Physics, Chemistry, Biology) and pass in English Core/ English Elective for general candidates / EWS candidates and for SC/ST/OBC/PWD candidates the marks obtained in their three core subject shall be 40%".
- b) For GNM candidates must have passed High Secondary (10+2) or equivalent conducted by recognised courcil in any discipline having minimum 40% in aggregate and having 40% in english language.
- c) Candidates are also eligible from State Open School recognized by State Government and National Institute of Open School (NIOS) recognized by Central Government having Science subjects and English only.
- d) English is a compulsory subject in 10+2 for being eligible for admission to B.Sc. (Nursing) & GNM Course.
- Colour blind candidates are eligible provided the colour corrective contact lens and spectacles are worn by such candidates.
- Candidates shall be medically fit.
- Married candidates are also eligible for admission.
- Students with JENPAS will be eligible.
- Candidate must passed west bengal joint entrance board examination 2023.
- Foreign Nationals:
  - The entry qualification equivalency i.e., standard will be obtained by Association of Indian Universities, New Delhi. Institution, SNRC and University will be responsible to ensure that the qualification and eligibility will be equivalent to what has been prescribed by the Council.
- Vaccination against Tetanus, Hepatitis B or any other communicable disease must be submitted during admission.
